

CAMERA POLICY FOR 600/390/392

Designated camera: Sony FX6

Additional cameras: Sony FX3, Sony RX0 (subject to availability)

Optional camera: 16/35mm film

Optional “thesis level” cameras: **ONLY** ARRI Alexa MINI (subject to approval [below] and availability).

ALL parameters below must be met.

“Thesis level” ARRI camera is **subject to availability and approval based on all these criteria:**

- Preliminary approval by faculty after submitted rationale;
- Camera manager based on demonstrable:
 - Ability e.g. - successfully **passed** intermediate or advanced class and training, training as employee in camera department, outside experience;
 - Sufficient staffing (*3 people (operator, 1st, 2nd - DP can be own operator)- Arri, 2 people - FX6 (operator and 1st)*)
 - Adequate transportation and secure storage;
- Head of Production - based on:
 - Responses above;
 - If International - risk management approval;
 - Internal department needs;
 - Additional questions;

Extenuating circumstances can affect availability, even if these are all met.
